Fourth Quarter Report on Donations Approved by OPGS for FY 2009

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2008-33 dated February 26, 2008, the Director of the Office of Partnerships and Grant Services (OPGS), in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General's Ethics Counselor, is publishing the District's Fourth Quarter Report on Donations for Fiscal Year 2009. The Order requires the OPGS Director to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor Memorandum 2002-1) and Section 115 of the D.C. Appropriations Act. This report includes data on all donation requests submitted to the OPGS Director for the period beginning July 1, 2009 and ending September 30, 2009. During this period, the OPGS Director approved the solicitation and/or acceptance of \$4,225,164.90 in donations of which \$378,500.00 represented financial contributions and \$3,846,664.90 were in-kind donations.
